### **Report**

7th May - The final inspection of work on church scar defence was held. Some issues were raised, commented on and left with officers to settle before the opening. Those in attendance were Steve Ball (Chief Engineer), Paul Walker (Director of Development Services) and myself (Councillor Threlfall). Church Scar opened to public shortly after.

27th May– A meeting at Granny's Bay took place 9am, present were Paul Walker, Darren Bell (Head of Technical Services), Steve Ball, VBA representatives – Mollington's representative, County Council roadways managers and officers and myself (Councillor Threlfall). After a lengthy discussion with LCC regarding the entrance into Fairhaven car park / barrier system and the road way responsibility, a way forward was agreed depending on the design of the entrance to Fairhaven carpark.

A final walk on Granny's bay defences was taken by Fylde officers and myself. An agreement was made to open given that the planted and grass areas were fenced off in time for 29 / 31st May or the following week depending on contract completion.
