SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner and The Lancashire Safeguarding Children Board have recently commissioned Sigma Consultancy (Lytham) Ltd to deliver Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) and Safeguarding Briefings to elected members.

The briefing will last no more than one hour and will cover CSE awareness and update members on the case picture within Fylde and provide further information regarding the work that is going on with taxi drivers in Lancashire.

The importance of the role of licensing in safeguarding vulnerable children and adults has been highlighted by recent events in Rotherham, Rochdale and Oxford. The Licensing Act 2003 also requires that a licensing authority must carry out its functions under the Act with a view to promoting the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm. As such, it is anticipated that the briefing will assist members when dealing with applications and making best use of the powers they have to protect the public.
