3. Chief Executive Job Evaluation – Service Review 2022

Tracy Manning, Deputy Chief Executive, introduced the report that detailed the findings from an independent consultant, who had been engaged to undertake the job evaluation of the post of the Chief Executive.

Linda Dutton, from the HR shared service in Blackpool, confirmed that she had been consulted upon the reevaluation of the job description of the Chief Executive and was satisfied with the details contained within the report.

Steve Traynor, the independent consultant at Stahrs Ltd, was invited to address the committee. In doing so Mr. Traynor gave a brief background to the Job Evaluation Scheme and provided a comparison with known Chief Executive pay levels at other local authorities.

It was unanimously RESOLVED to note the outcome of the Chief Executive post job evaluation outcome included in the report and approve the implementation of the pay bands, listed at Table 1 of the report, to commence from April 1st, 2022.
