

## **Decision Notice**

## Decision

The Council had received an application for a premises licence at the China House Take Away, 13 St Davids Road South, St Annes. There had been an objection from the Lancashire Fire and Rescue Service who is a responsible authority under the Licensing Act. There had also been written objections from persons living in the vicinity of the premises.

The Panel considered the written representations from the interested parties. The Panel also had regard to the responsible authority that made representations. In addition, the panel also heard from Tina Shi on behalf of the applicant.

The Panel considered that it was necessary for the promotion of the licensing objective of public safety for the extra conditions as agreed between the responsible authority (Lancashire Fire and Rescue Service) and the applicant to be placed on the premises licence. In addition, the Panel also considered it necessary for the promotion of the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance for the additional condition to be placed on the licence requiring the premises to close at 23.30 each evening as agreed by the applicant.

Accordingly, the Panel granted the licence as applied for, subject to those conditions, conditions reflecting the operating schedule and the mandatory conditions.
