- To ask that the Chief Executive, inasmuch as it lies within his power now Mr White is no longer employed by the Council, investigates thoroughly the circumstances outlined in this matter, with a view to ensuring that proper open, and transparent procedures are followed in all future shared service or reorganisation exercises.
- To pay Appellant A and Appellant B a token sum of £500 each in recognition of the stress they have been placed under and the time and trouble they have taken to bring matters to this point.
