Reason for Hearing	Receipt of an application for a review of a premises licence at 1AM, Pleasant St, Lytham Relevant representations received from the Police.

The Licensing Authority has received an application for the review of the premises licence at 1AM, Pleasant St, Lytham.

Representations have been received to the application from Lancashire Constabulary who are a Responsible Authority under the Act.

This means that the Committee must consider the application.

We have heard representations from Mr. Horne who presented the objections made by Lancashire Constabulary. The police objection is based on crimes that have taken place on the premises and test purchase.

The Panel also heard evidence from Phillip Dent.

The Panel heard representations from Mr. Whiteman who informed the panel of actions taken to address issues raised by the Police.

The panel noted and accepted the evidence submitted by the police in connection with incidents taking place both within and outside the premises and the times at which such incidents had occurred namely after midnight. This can be substantiated by the representations submitted by local residents irrespective of their non attendance today.

The panel also expressed concern about the record keeping and proof of age scheme operated at the premises.

DECISION

Taking into account the Information put before us, the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the Guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 we have decided as follows:

1. That the conditions of the licence be amended so that all licensable activities be required to cease at midnight on Friday and Saturday and that all amplified music also be required to cease curtailed to midnight on Friday and Saturday.
2. That additional conditions on the licence be inserted in the licence to secure as follows:
 - That all windows and doors remain closed during operating hours.
 - That a noise limiter be installed in the premises and that the restrictive noise levels be determined by Fylde Borough Council.
3. That the licence holder be urged to liaise with Fylde Borough Council licensing staff to receive advice on appropriate record keeping covering all licensing activities.
