#### Mayor's Welcome

It was moved by Councillor Roger Small, and seconded by Councillor Vivienne Willder and;

RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY that Councillor Christine Akeroyd be appointed Mayor of the Borough of Fylde for the ensuing municipal year.

(The Mayor also indicated that her appointee as Mayoress was Miss Helen Akeroyd).

After making the Declaration of the Acceptance of Office, as required by statute, the Mayor thereupon occupied the chair.

2. <u>To Appoint a Deputy Mayor for the Borough of Fylde for the Ensuing Municipal Year.</u>

It was moved by the Mayor, Councillor Christine Akeroyd, seconded by Councillor Karen Buckley and RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY that Councillor Angela Jacques be appointed Deputy Mayor of Fylde for the ensuing municipal year.

The Deputy Mayor thereupon made the Declaration of Acceptance of Office as required by Statute.

(The Deputy Mayor also indicated that her appointee as Deputy Mayoress was Miss Sarah Jacques).

### Vote of Thanks

The Mayor, on behalf of the Council, expressed her thanks and congratulations to Councillor Peter Hardy on his year of office.

Presentation of the Illuminated Record and Badge to the Immediate Past Mayor together with the Immediate Past Mayoress's Badge.

The Mayor, on behalf of the Council, presented to the immediate Past Mayor (Councillor Peter Hardy) an illuminated record containing the resolution of the Council electing his to the office of Mayor of the Borough for the year 2015/2016.

The Mayor also presented Councillor Peter Hardy his Past Mayor's Badge and to Mrs Sheila Hardy, her Past Mayoress's Badge.

#### 4. Confirmation of minutes

#### 5. Mayor's Announcements

The Mayor announced that the meeting of the Council marked a first at Fylde Borough Council. Councillor Louis Rigby was the first elected member to serve 40 years as a Councillor for Fylde Borough Council. Councillor Rigby was elected on May 6<sup>th</sup> 1976, only two years after the Fylde Council had been formed.

She advised that it had been 25 years since Councillor Rigby served as Mayor in 1991-92 and during his 40 years of exceptional service he had been appointed to 17 committees, from Leisure and

Amenities in 1976 to Environment, Health and Housing in 2016, attending hundreds of meeting on behalf of the people of Fylde.

The Mayor went on to say that everyone in the chamber and those who had served in the past had the utmost respect for Councillor Rigby as well as wonderful stories to tell of his work, or his antics, over the last 40 years.

She advised that whilst there were no procedures for recognising 40 years of elected service primarily because most did not last that long, the members and officers of Fylde Council were not going to allow such an achievement to pass without recognition.

The Mayor then presented Councillor Louis Rigby with a token of appreciation for his service.

The Mayor went on to informed members that Reverend Nicholas Wells would be her Mayor's Chaplain for the forthcoming year.

The Mayor also announced that Civic Sunday would take place on Sunday 22 May 2016 at St Cuthbert's Church, Lytham. The service would commence at 10.00am.

The Mayor concluded by announcing that the Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Families Association (SSAFA); Home Start Blackpool, Fylde and Wyre and the Girlguiding Kilgrimol Centre would be her Mayoral charities for the municipal year.
