“Following a request by a number of councillors, a special Council meeting has been called on 9th March to discuss matters relating to Lytham Institute. The Institute is held by the Council in trust for the community, and is subject to Charity Law rather than Local Government law. Will councillors, as trustees, be able to vote freely and independently on the Institute, regardless of party politics?”
