	At the time that the agenda was published the expectation was that the applicant would be able to provide some additional plans relating to the landscaping, replacement tree planting, and the ecological enhancements works that would be delivered by the development. Although some information has been received, this is under consideration by the planning and tree officer.	
	Whilst it is relatively unusual to require this information for an application relating to a single dwelling, officers feel it is necessary in this case given the scale of the site and its plot and the need to deliver a high quality visual and ecological environment as a consequence of the scheme. To allow time for this to be considered further and any revisions sought officers suggest that the recommendation be revised from the grant of planning permission to one where the authority to grant planning permission is delegated to the Head of Planning.
