It has also been approved by the relevant committee at Blackpool Council.</li> <li>In the forthcoming year, it is anticipated that there will be planning applications brought forward to Fylde in connection with a) a new Sports Village, b) a junction off Queensway to provide additional access to the Enterprise Zone from the south side and c) Airport operational facilities.</li> <li>The governance arrangements have now been re-structured to provide a Joint Committee made up of the Leaders of all three Councils, the Chief Executives and co-opted non-voting members from the private sector.
